



Featured Artist: Bam Da Skoolboy

Bam Da Schoolboy generates energy out of Newark, New Jersey and has a number of releases distributed by SongCast. He wrote and recorded his first track when he was only 11.

"I was always into music," he remembers. "My father was into music, my oldest cousin taught me how to write bars. I went to the studio at 11 years old and recorded my first track."

25 years later, Bam reflects on how the music scene has changed. "It has changed a lot," he begins. "Back in the day, it was all about sound. You had to really find your sound, back in the day, to stand out from others."

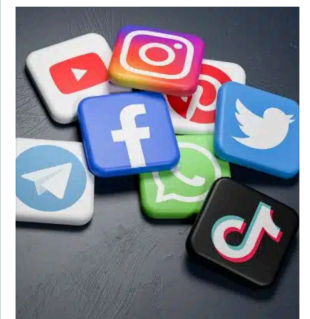

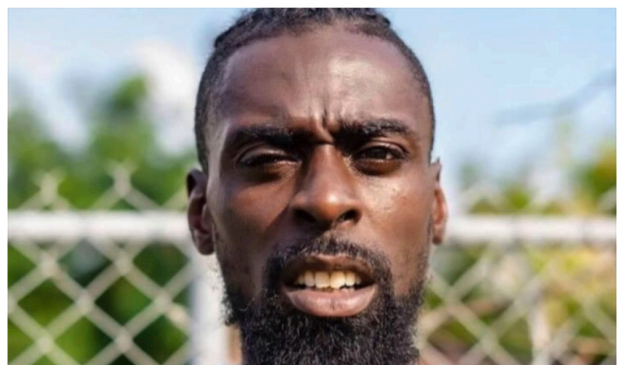

"I get a beat first and then write around the beat."

Our conversation turned to a song called "Corrupted." "Corrupted is positive. I really had to be different with this one. Had to show people like, what we're livin' in, it could be better."

We asked Bam what makes his music different from everyone else in the genre. He was quick to reply. "My sound. Definitely my creativity, my energy."

We asked how long it takes to construct a track and if he writes lyrics in advance, freestyles, or both. "I do both, it depends on the feeling."

He says he can usually get out of the studio in less than an hour for one track.

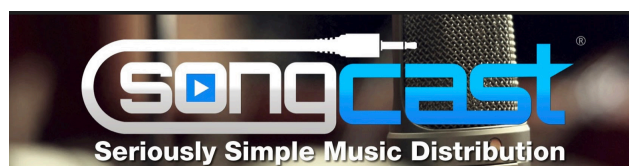
