Sweez is from Atlanta, Georgia and is inventing his own style of hip hop, as an emcee who expresses himself subliminally, turning derision and anxiety into art.

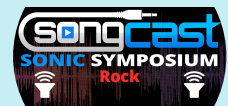

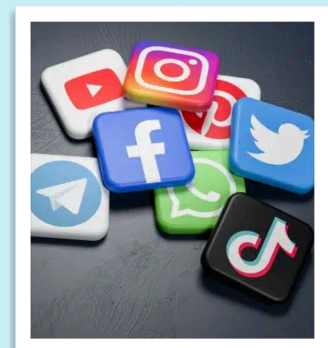

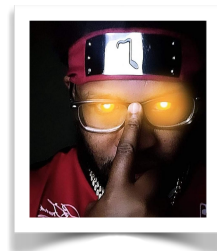
Or rap release, which is very hard to say in this saturated genre.

We asked Sweez how long it takes to put together one of his tracks. "It takes a minute, because I'll build a base and once I build that base, I'll leave it alone for awhile. Then I'll come back in a month or two and pull up that base and add something else and I'll leave it again. (Laughs) Sometimes, I'll add too much and have to take pieces off. It takes time, cause I want to give it that feeling that I'm looking for."

Sweez says he typically has 70-100 tracks that he is working on at any given time. "I make beats on my cell phone and my Mac computer, but my software isn't all the way up to date like a lot of producers out there, so I do with it what I can."

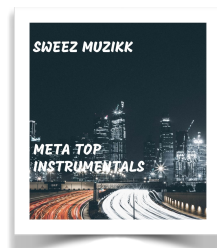
We asked Sweez why he chooses instrumental music and why he doesn't rap. "I don't like expressing myself through words. These beats are how I express myself," he begins. "For me, whenever I am in a dark place, or I feel low, or depressed, I will just put it up to my tracks and it will help express it for me. I did throw one out there that I was rappin' on is called "Trapped In My Darkness."
